GENERAL FUNCTIONS:

Concession Stand Attendant – To help The Miracle League raise money by working the concession stands preparing food and serving drinks at Milwaukee Brewer games. If you are unable to be present, please notify the Program Manager ASAP.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- All volunteers must be 18 years-old or older
- Approximately 2-3 hour shift per night
- Each event - each group must : inventory before and after each event, set up, prepare all food, cashiering, customer service, money managing, and thorough clean-up within their booth, all with a Miracle League manager's guidance.
- Training is required for each person. Trainings can be done on game day or previously scheduled date.
- Groups do not have to train together –or on the same day
- Each group must provide one Group Leader to organize your group and work with the Coordinator via e-mail.
- We provide: part of the required uniform(tshirt), a free sausage and drink each event.
